The candidates are expected to have a basic knowledge of stable management, driving a single, knowledge about harness and how to 'put to' safely. The day gives everyone the opportunity see a wide variety of turnouts, equipment, get some hands on experience, meet new people and have some fun whilst learning. The day is very informative and friendly and even if you do not win, every young adult taking part will improve their driving knowledge.

The winners of the award, worth £500, will be given the opportunity to take tuition from a BDS approved instructor of their choice.

All who wish to apply should check that they are able to be taken to Norfolk on August 12th, and then apply on the adjacent form and return as soon as possible, but no later than July 15th.
