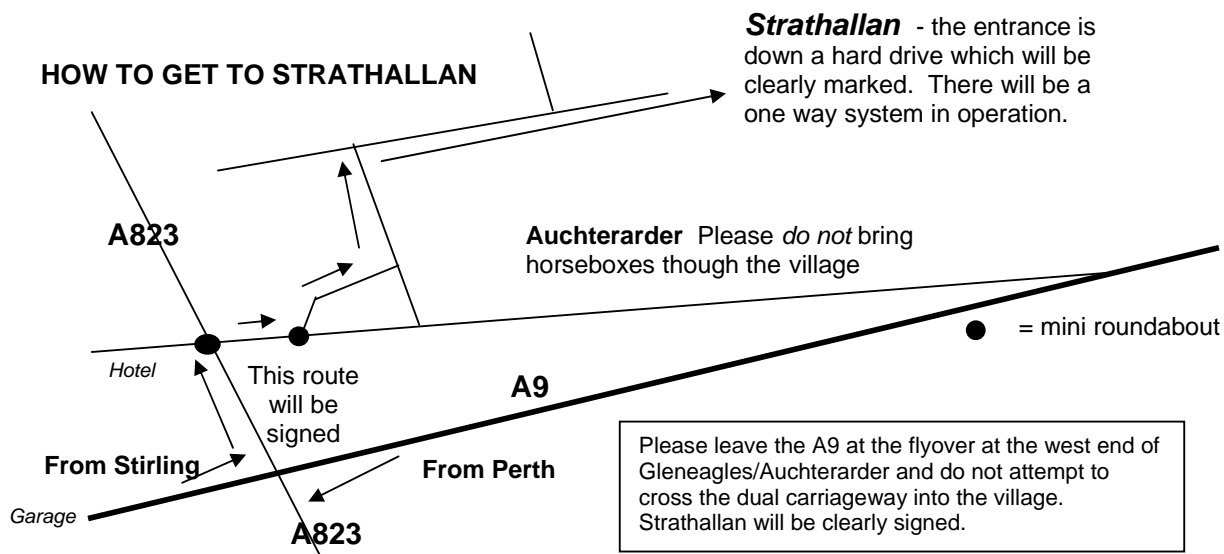

The highest placed turnout owned and driven by a member of the British Driving Society and eligible for the following Sections (disregarding those already qualified) down to 6th place in the class will qualify for the 2007 semi- Finals. The Championships will immediately follow the Semi-Finals.

- g Single purebred Registered Welsh Poinies Sections A and B
- h Single Registered Mountain & Moorland (excluding purebred Welsh)
- l Single turnout driving to a 2 wheeled exercise vehicle
- m Single turnout driving to a 4 wheeled exercise vehicle
- n Pair put to a 4 wheeled exercise vehicle
- o Single turnout driven to a traditional type vehicle by a young driver aged 10-14 years
- p Single turnout driven to a traditional type vehicle by a young driver aged 15-17 years
- q Single turnout driven to an exercise vehicle by a young driver aged 10-14 years
- r Single turnout driven to an exercise vehicle by a young driver aged 15-17 years

Saturday Starting at Noon

Class Treasure Hunt

The drive will take approximately 1 hour and will be over fields, roads and tracks. Most suitable for Exercise and Utility Vehicles but everyone welcome to join in. All turnouts will require a groom/writer. Additional passengers can accompany drivers if the vehicle is suitable. Competitors competing in the Dressage/Cones can start their drive when they have completed those competitions. This class will run throughout the afternoon. There will be a timetable available to book in your start time.

Ring 1 Fun Indoor Driving Outdoors. Dressage and Cones will be held on the Saturday Timed Obstacles on Sunday afternoon

Competitors can enter any section individually and the overall competition. Rosettes given in each section for each class and overall. It is hoped that competitors entering these classes on Saturday will also join in the showing classes on Sunday morning.

DRESSAGE – Starting Noon

Exercise/Marathon Turnout – no lamps required. Tests available on SCDA website (Reference section) or with a SAE from the Secretary.

Dressage Class 1 Novice/Single BHDTA Novice 2007

If you are not driving in Club Open classes nor in a Beginners Class, this is the class for you.

Dressage Class 2 Pre Novice BHDTA PreNovice A 2007

This class is for Beginners who have not been driving in any Driving Trials competitions prior to 2006 or who have not been placed 1 - 3 in any Club Beginner/Pre Novice class in 2006/07. This class is intended for those fairly new to driving.

Dressage Class 3 Open Drivers/Single/Multiples BHDTA Intermediate 2007

For drivers who drive in any Open Single/Multiple class in Club Open or any National classes.

Ring 2 CONES – to follow on immediately after dressage.

Same classes as for dressage.

Novice and Open – cones to proper BHDTA width if possible. If not inform judges.

Pre Novice bring whatever vehicle you have, regardless of width.

Classes may be amalgamated, split or cancelled as entries dictate. (If you rely on a late entry your class may have disappeared.) The timetable may vary depending on numbers of entries. The final timetable will be available on the Saturday.

4.00		Private Driving Championship <i>Open to all show class winners. The judges will select 6 finalists who will then perform an individual show. These shows will be marked independently by the 3 judges by showing their scores (as at the Osbourne finals). The champion will be the turnout with the highest mark. In the event of an equal score a further judge will select the winner from those with the equal scores.</i>

3.00	20	Sporting Single Class <i>The driver will drive a single cones course. They will go into a box and remove the carriage. Then they will ride the cones course which will have some simple obstacles/jumps. (The driver and rider do not have to be the same person.) The clock will be kept running throughout and additional penalties will be given for faults.</i>
3.30	21	Novelty Cones Class <i>A cones course with a fun twist.</i>
