Hackney Show Wagons, trade turnouts and vehicles with pneumatic tyres (except Classes 1 & 3) are not eligible.

- 1 NOVICE HACKNEY or NON-HACKNEY – SINGLES – Any height** **OR*(o)(p)**
YOUNG DRIVER TRADITIONAL TYPE VEHICLE
Please read Rule 5.8, first paragraph only applies.
Special rosette to the highest placed pony/horse in an exercise cart
- 2 EXERCISE CARTS – SINGLES & PAIRS – Any height** **OR*(l)(m)(n)(q)(r)**
Lamps need not be carried.
- 3 PLEASURE DRIVE – Any height**
Pleasure Drive classes are for newcomers to showing and not intended for those who show in private driving classes. Regular showing competitors are asked to respect this and entries for the Pleasure Driving class will not be accepted from those who enter Private Driving classes.

Pleasure Driving will be judged 15% on vehicle suitability, fit and cleanliness, 15% on harness suitability, fit and cleanliness and 70% on driver and groom, horse/pony's way of going and suitability as a family pleasure driving animal. Competitors may be required to drive and halt between two pairs of cones and execute a U turn in their individual show.
- 4 REGISTERED WELSH SECTION A, B, C – SINGLES/MULTIPLES** **OR*(f)(g) HOYS**
Registration numbers must be included on the entry form.
Horse of the Year Show qualifier. The first and Second placed competitors of this class must compete in the Show Supreme Championship at 4pm. The winner of this class will qualify for the HOYS Championship on 4th-9th October 2011. **Entry fee for this class + £10.50 Horse of the Year Show contribution.** If you are entering more than one of these classes you need only pay the additional £10.50 once.
- 5 PAIRS & TANDEM** **OR*(i)HOYS**
Horse of the Year Show qualifier. The first and Second placed competitors of this class must compete in the Show Supreme Championship at 4pm. The winner of this class will qualify for the HOYS Championship on 4th-9th October 2011. **Entry fee for this class + £10.50 Horse of the Year Show contribution.** If you are entering more than one of these classes you need only pay the additional £10.50 once.
- 6 REGISTERED WELSH SECTION D – SINGLES/MULTIPLES** **OR*(e)HOYS**
Registration numbers must be included on the entry form.
Horse of the Year Show qualifier. The first and Second placed competitors of this class must compete in the Show Supreme Championship at 4pm. The winner of this class will qualify for the HOYS Championship on 4th-9th October 2011. **Entry fee for this class + £10.50 Horse of the Year Show contribution.** If you are entering more than one of these classes you need only pay the additional £10.50 once.
- 7 NON-HACKNEY TYPE – SINGLES – Over 13.2 hh** **OR*(b)HOYS**
Horse of the Year Show qualifier. The first and second placed competitors of this class must compete in the Show Supreme Championship at 4pm. The winner of this class will qualify for the HOYS Championship on 4th-9th October 2011. **Entry fee for this class + £10.50 Horse of the Year Show contribution.** If you are entering more than one of these classes you need only pay the additional £10.50 once.
- 8 NON-HACKNEY TYPE – SINGLES – 13.2 hh and under** **OR*(c) HOYS**



Horse of the Year Show qualifier. The first and Second placed competitors of this class must compete in the Show Supreme Championship at 4pm. The winner of this class will qualify for the HOYS Championship on 4th-9th October 2011. **Entry fee for this class + £10.50 Horse of the Year Show contribution.** If you are entering more than one of these classes you need only pay the additional £10.50 once.

- 10 COUNTRY TURNOUT – SINGLES/MULTIPLES Any height. OR*(d) HOYS**
Horse of the Year Show qualifier. The first and Second placed competitors of this class must compete in the Show Supreme Championship at 4pm. The winner of this class will qualify for the HOYS Championship on 4th-9th October 2011. **Entry fee for this class + £10.50 Horse of the Year Show contribution.** If you are entering more than one of these classes you need only pay the additional £10.50 once.
- 11 REGISTERED MOUNTAIN and MOORLAND (exc. WELSH) OR*(h) HOYS**
Horse of the Year Show qualifier. The first and Second placed competitors of this class must compete in the Show Supreme Championship at 4pm. The winner of this class will qualify for the HOYS Championship on 4th-9th October 2011. **Entry fee for this class + £10.50 Horse of the Year Show contribution.** If you are entering more than one of these classes you need only pay the additional £10.50 once.
- 12 LIGHT TRADE 2 & 4 WHEEL OR*(j)(k)**
- 13 SHOW SUPREME CHAMPIONSHIP**
TO BE HELD IN THE MAIN RING
The first and second from classes 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10 & 11 to compete.
The winner of this class qualifies for the Horse of the Year Show

OR*

These classes are a qualifier for the **2011 Osborne Refrigerators BDS National Championship.** The highest placed turnout owned and driven by a member of the British Driving Society and eligible for the following type-section/s disregarding those already qualified down to 6th place in the class will qualify for the 2011 Semi-Finals. The Championship will immediately follow the Semi-Finals.

Type Sections

- (a) – Single hackney-type
- (b) – Single non-hackney type (excluding purebred Registered Welsh) over 13.2hh
- (c) – Single non-hackney type (excluding purebred Registered Welsh) 13.2hh & under
- (d) – Single Country Turnout
- (e) – Single purebred Registered Welsh Cobs – Section D
- (f) – Single purebred Registered Welsh Ponies – Section C
- (g) – Single purebred Registered Welsh Ponies – Sections A & B
- (h) – Single Registered Mountain & Moorland (excluding purebred Registered Welsh)
- (i) – Pairs & Tandems – Open. Any height
- (j) – Two wheel Light Trade
- (k) – Four wheel Light Trade
- (m) – Single Turnout driven to a four-wheel exercise vehicle.
- (n) – Pair or tandem put to an exercise vehicle.
- (o) – Single turnout driven to a traditional type vehicle by a young driver aged 10 – 14 years
- (p) – Single turnout driven to a traditional type vehicle by a young driver aged 15 – 17 years
- (q) – Single turnout driven to an exercise vehicle by a young driver aged 10 – 14 years
- (r) – Single turnout driven to an exercise vehicle by a young driver aged 15 – 17 years



CHAMPIONSHIP QUALIFICATION

THE SINGLES CHAMPIONSHIP -

The First and Second Prize Winners from classes 7 and 8 must compete immediately after Class 8 in Ring 1.

THE SHOW SUPREME CHAMPIONSHIP –

First and Second prize winners from class 4,5,6,7,8,10 & 11 and the Singles Driving Champion and Reserve Champion must compete at 4.00 in THE MAIN RING.

THE SCOTTISH POINTS CHAMPIONSHIP -

To be awarded to the highest placed Scottish Owner-Exhibitor. Points towards the Brownlie Trophy will be awarded in all classes.

STABLING AND ACCOMMODATION

Competitors' caravans and horse boxes are allowed onto the Showground the day before the Show. If overnight stabling is required, please contact the Show Director.

ENTRIES

Entries must be received by the Entries Secretary by 1st July 2011 and cheques made payable to the British Driving Society, Scottish Show.
No telephone entries.

If, where required on the entry form, the Stud Book Registration number is omitted, the entry will be returned.

SHOW RULES

1. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

So far as permitted by law the Show Organiser, the Society, its officers, employees and representatives will not be liable to any person whosoever whilst upon, entering, or leaving the Showground for any loss, damage, death injury or accident to persons or property or for lost or stolen items.

2. INDEMNITY

Each Exhibitor must keep the Society its officers, employees and representatives fully indemnified against all losses, actions, costs, claims, demands and expenses arising directly or indirectly out of any act, omission or negligence by him or by anyone attending the Show in connection with his entry or otherwise expressly or impliedly with his authority. Therefore all Exhibitors, Competitors and Owners are strongly advised to take out third-party liability insurance. The Society cannot advise on policies or their suitability and it is the individual's responsibility to obtain advice wherever necessary.

3. SAFETY

- 3.1 All animals must be under proper control at all times within the Showground. All dogs must be kept on leads and loose dogs are liable to be impounded.
- 3.2 Exhibitors, Owners and Competitors are personally responsible for ensuring that they take all necessary measures with regard to health and safety.
- 3.3 It is recommended that all horseboxes and trailers are fitted with a fire extinguisher of not less than 1 kilo capacity.

4. ENTRIES

- 4.1 All horses/ponies entered for the Show must be the bona fide property of a Member and driven by a Member (except in the Hackney Classes at the Society's Annual Show, Smiths Lawn) provided that entries may be made by corporate bodies where the driver is a Member, and in Ride and Drive Classes the driver only is required to be a Member.
- 4.2 No Member whose subscription to the Society is unpaid will be allowed to exhibit or compete, not withstanding acceptance of any entry fee.
- 4.3 The Society will not be liable for any error which may appear in any programme or for any entry made in the wrong class.
- 4.4 All entries must be made on an official entry form and are to be sent with the appropriate fees to arrive with the Show Organiser on or before the closing date for entries.
- 4.5 Exhibitors who cancel their entries will only be refunded their entry fees on production of a valid veterinary certificate certifying the entered horse/pony is unable to compete on the day of the Show.
- 4.6 No substitution or transfer of any entry will be allowed after the closing date for entries. In all cases horses entered must be named on the entry form and no entry with a general nomination will be accepted.
- 4.7 The Society reserves the right to reject or cancel any entry entirely at its discretion and without prior notice or the need to give any reason for doing so.
- 4.8 An Exhibitor making an entry shall be deemed to accept and abide by these Show Rules.

5. ORGANISATION AND JUDGING

- 5.1 The Society reserves the right to appoint such Judges as the Society in its absolute discretion may decide and to change any Judges without prior notice. In classes 19,20-23 & 25 the Society reserves the right to appoint a judge from outside the BDS Judges panel.
- 5.2 The Society reserves the right to cancel any class or classes, refunding any fees paid in respect thereof.
- 5.3 Judges' decisions shall be final and Judges shall not be obliged to explain their decisions or actions nor enter into correspondence regarding them.
- 5.4 Owners will permit random drug/dope tests to be taken from horses/ponies on request by the Society.
- 5.5 Turnouts which, in the opinion of a Judge, ring steward or other official of the Society, represent a safety risk, or potential hazard must leave the showing immediately upon request.
- 5.6 Any competitor whose conduct is, in the opinion of a Judge, inappropriate must leave the showing immediately upon request.
- 5.7 If a turnout is not present in the showing when required, it will be subject to disqualification at the discretion of the Judge
- 5.8 Classifications are as follows:
 - ◆ a novice horse/pony means an animal which has not won a First Prize or a First Prize Rosette, in harness, prior to 1st January in the year of the Show.
 - ◆ at the Society's Annual Show, Smith's Lawn, a Novice Whip means a person who has not won a First Prize or a First Prize Rosette, in any event/show affiliated to either the Society, the Hackney Horse Society or the British Horse Driving Trials Association prior to 1st January in the year of the Show.
 - ◆ a Traditional Vehicle means a vehicle of traditional profile and identifiable type to resemble the design of a carriage built prior to the First World War. The vehicle may be made from modern materials but must have traditional style springing and carriage lamps.

6. EXHIBITORS AND EXHIBITS

- 6.1 No horse, pony, donkey or mule under the age of four years may be entered.
- 6.2 Grooms must be not less than 11 years old on the day of the Show and of a competence in keeping with the turnout concerned. At all times when driving on the Showground (whether or not in a ring) whips under the age of 18 MUST be accompanied by a competent and experienced adult groom aged 18 or over. This regulation applies at all times and in all areas on the showground. Any dispute as to a person's age or the age of an animal shall be determined in the absolute discretion of the relevant Judge where the dispute arises in relation to a particular class, and by the Show Committee in other instances. The Judge's or Show Committee's decision is final. Hackney Horse Society rules apply in relation to young drivers in Classes 20–23 & 35.

7. PRIZES

- 7.1 The method of awarding prize money if any, whether in a show ring, by post after the Show or any other method will be at the discretion of the Show Committee.
- 7.2 Winners of trophies shall be responsible for having them appropriately engraved and shall return them at their own cost in good and clean condition by registered post as directed by the Show Organiser at least one month before the date of the next Show. Winners must ensure that any trophies are adequately packed and indemnify the Society against any loss or damage to any trophy whilst in their care or in transit.

8. PROTESTS AND DISPUTES

- 8.1 Any exhibitor wishing to make a protest, in relation to any aspect of the Show, must make the same in writing to the Show Organiser (and where such protest relates to an animal exhibited or other issue relating to a Class such protest must be made within 30 minutes of the Class being judged), and deposit the sum of £20.00 in cash which may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be forfeited to the funds of the Society if the objection is disallowed.
- 8.2 Any protest shall be decided by the Show Committee, of which a quorum of three members shall be required and, if necessary, the Chairman of the Show Committee shall have a casting vote. The decision of the Show Committee shall be final and it shall not be obliged to explain its decisions or enter into correspondence regarding them.
- 8.3 All disputes regarding these Rules or their interpretation shall be referred to the Show Committee, whose decision shall be final.

9. DEFINITIONS

In these Rules:

"Society" means the British Driving Society Ltd., (Company Registration Number 04612597) Registered Office: Templars House, Lulworth Close, Chandlers Ford, Hampshire SO53 3TL including where appropriate its officers, employees and representatives.

"the Show Organiser" means the person appointed by or on behalf of the Society to administer and organise the Show.

"the Show" means either the Society's Annual Show in Smith's Lawn Windsor or the Society's Scottish Show (as appropriate)

"the Show Committee" means the Society's committee constituted from time to time with primary responsibility for the Show

"the Showground" means the site of the Show and its environs

"Exhibitor" means a person who submits an entry form in accordance with these Rules whether or not also an Owner or Competitor

"Owner" means an owner of a horse, pony or vehicle entered in a class at the Show

"Competitor" means a driver of a turnout at the Show whether or not an Exhibitor or Owner

"Member" means a member of the Society.

The singular includes the plural and the masculine the feminine and vice versa.
