- Starting, and finishing, at The Cottage Inn, where parking and putting to will be in an adjoining paddock (in main entrance, thro' car park into field behind)
- Maps provided for an approx. 10 mile route on quiet roads/lanes; there may also be a shorter route of approx. 5 miles
- Turnouts set off a timed intervals (your start time will be emailed to you);
- At marked points answers to clues must be found - all can be seen without alighting from the carriage.
- On return, afternoon tea provided by The Cottage Inn from 3pm (£10 a person, payable with Entry Form)

BDS Berks "Turned out Well" Mugs : were introduced at our Windsor Great Park event last year. Points are given at the turnout inspection at the start of the drive on the basis of harness fit and safety, cleanliness of harness, equine, carriage and the overall effort to turn out well. It is open to all not judged on the monetary value of equipment and irrespective of the type of turnout. Top scorers will be awarded their Mug at the end of each event.

All drivers will receive a commemorative rosette.
