

Rules & Conditions of Entry

1. The organisers do not accept liability for any accident, damage, injury to owners, animals, drivers, spectators, or any other person or property whatsoever.
2. The organisers reserve the right to cancel any class, refunding any fees paid in respect thereof.
3. The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry as they deem necessary.
4. The organisers reserve the right to substitute any judge without prior warning.
5. Refund of entry will only be given on the cancellation of either the class, the show or the presentation of a vet certificate.
6. Horses and ponies entered in any class must be 4 years old or older.
7. A novice horse/pony is defined as a pony that has not won a first prize in any driven class prior to 1st January this year.
8. A novice driver is defined as a driver who has not won a first prize in any driven class prior to 1st January this year.
9. The decision of the judge is final.
10. No substitution or nomination entry will be accepted.
11. No pony may be entered that has been bred, sold, leased or produced by the judge or his/her immediate family or employer.
12. All M&M ponies entered into M&M classes must be registered with their appropriate breed societies.
13. All competitors must have third party public liability insurance, and this may be inspected at any time during the show by the show organisers.
14. Animals that behave in a hazardous or uncontrolled manner, in the opinion of the stewards, the judges or the show organisers, will be asked to leave the ring, and or the show.
15. All towing vehicles and lorries should carry a suitable fire extinguisher.
16. All exhibitors should be fully paid up members of the British Driving Society (BDS). The turnout should be the bone fide property of a member of the BDS. The driver should be a BDS member.
17. Young drivers (young whips) under the age of 18 years must be accompanied in the turnout by an adult (over the age of 18 years) groom, who themselves is a competent carriage driver at all times on the show ground. Show organisers reserve the right to ask for proof of age of the groom.

The highest placed turnout, owned and driven, by a member of the British Driving Society and eligible for the following type sections disregarding those already qualified down to 6th place in the class, will qualify for the 2019 semi-finals. The Championship will immediately follow the semi-finals.

- Class 8 (a) Single hackney-type over 13.2hh
- Class 8 (b) Single hackney-type 13.2hh & under
- Class 8 (e) Country Turnout – single, pair or tandem
- Class 8 (f) Single purebred Registered Welsh cob – Section D
- Class 8 (g) Single purebred Registered Welsh Ponies – Sections A,B & C
- Class 8 (i) Pairs & Tandems – Open. Any height
- Class 4 (l) Single or tandem turnout driven to a two wheel exercise vehicle
- Class 4 (m) Single or tandem turnout driven to a four wheel exercise vehicle

This is a **Victoria Food Company Open Private Driving Championship Qualifier**, the Private Driving Champion will qualify for the 2019 Grand Final to be held at the David Broome Event Centre, Crick, Monmouthshire on 14th & 15th September 2019. In the event that the Champion has already qualified, then the Reserve Champion to qualify. If the Reserve has qualified, the Rosette to be awarded to the Champion. Once qualified, the horse, whip and vehicle may not be changed.

Exercise Vehicle Points Championship

Points will be awarded for exercise vehicles placed in classes 1,2,3,5,6 and 8. (1st = 6 points through to 6th = 1 point), with a drivers top three placings counting towards this championship.

Junior Driver Points Championship

Points will be awarded for each class entered, (1st = 6 points through to 6th =1). with all placing counting towards this championship.

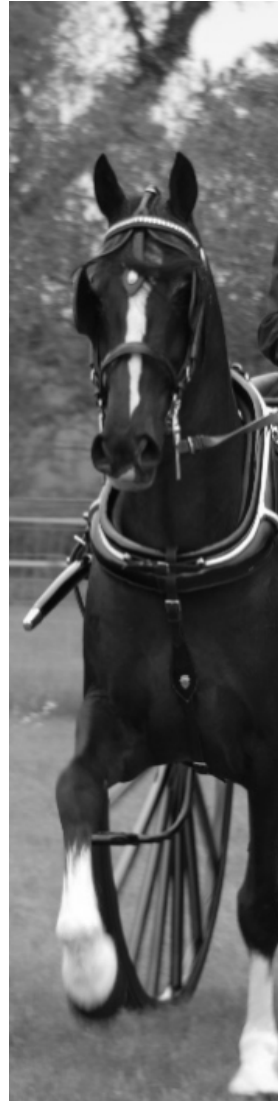
