Horses and ponies must be 4 years and over.

They will be split at heights according to the number of entries we receive.

We are commencing with a harness inspection.

Followed by a timed road drive of approximately 5 – 6 miles through country lanes.

On return Competitors will be asked to undertake an obstacle skills course.

This will be followed by a cones course.

Points are then added up from each section to find the overall winner for each Class.

N.B. Parking is available on hard standing opposite the farm and also in the field where the competition is to be held. The start point will be in the field next to the stable yard.

- 1. The Judge's decision is final.**
- 2. Instructions must be strictly adhered to.**
- 3. Hard hats must be worn at all times.**
- 4. All entries must have their own third party insurance cover.**
- 5. No entry money will be refunded unless a Vet's Certificate is produced.**
- 6. The organisers reserve the right to omit or amalgamate any class due to lack of entries.**
- 7. While the organisers and land owners will take every care to ensure the health and safety of everyone present, no liability will be accepted for loss or damage however caused.**
- 8. All entrants must be current members of the British Driving Society and membership numbers are to be provided on the entry form.**

OBSTACLE SKILLS COURSE.

**PLEASE WALK THE OBSTACLE COURSE BEFORE THE COMPETITION STARTS.
NO COMPETITORS WILL BE ABLE TO WALK THE COURSE BETWEEN ENTRIES.**

OBSTACLE 1. (20 METRE CIRCLES).

At X halt for 10 seconds. Take 2-3 strides in walk and then trot a 20 metre circle to the right and at X do a 20 metre circle to the left.
Halt at X – salute the Judge.

MARKS OUT OF 10 =

OBSTACLE 2. (SERPENTINE AROUND CONES).

Trot a serpentine between the cones.

MARKS OUT OF 10 =

OBSTACLE 3. (DRUMS OBSTACLE).

Trot between the gates of A,B,C,D & E. Do not go through a letter before “opening” a gate in alphabetical order. Once you have opened a gate you can re-use it.

MARKS OUT OF 10 =

OBSTACLE 4. (STEPPING STONES)

Your Groom to step along and back on the stones, while the Driver goes around the stones and collects Groom back at Starting Point.

MARKS OUT OF 10 =

OBSTACLE 5. (HORSE MOUTH)

Get as many balls as possible through the mouth of the horse in One Minute.

GROOM TO PUT BALLS BACK IN BUCKET BEFORE PROCEEDING.

MARKS OUT OF 10 =

OBSTACLE 6. (POST BOX)

Groom to post a letter – more marks given if the groom does not dismount.

MARKS OUT OF 10 =

OBSTACLE 7. (BRIDGE)

Trot through the bales and over “mat”

MARKS OUT OF 10 =

OBSTACLE 8. (DOG LEG)

Walk through Dog Leg and then turn outside and Trot back through.

MARKS OUT OF 10 =

OBSTACLE 9. (GATE)

Go to gate where the entrance is to the Cones Course. Stop – groom to dismount and open gate, driver to go through and wait for groom to close the gate and to mount back up.
