### **To Start Promptly at 9.30am**

#### **Class 1      IN HAND POTENTIAL DRIVING HORSE, PONY OR DONKEY**

Open to horses, ponies and donkeys, 4 years old or above.

Winner to receive the In Hand Driving Trophy.

Highest placed donkey to receive the Uncle Mo Trophy.

This class is kindly sponsored by Samantha Searle of Grayswood Carriage Driving and Stud.

#### **Class 2      RIDE AND DRIVE      Ridden section**

Open to horses and ponies any height to be shown under saddle at all paces.

Riders need not be the whips. To be judged on condition, manners and turnout.

Final placings will be decided on completion of the Driven section.

Winner to receive the Tom Parker Farm Trophy.

This Class is kindly sponsored by Miss Caroline Douglas.

#### **Class 3      NOVICE HORSE OR PONY**

Open to horses and ponies any height, any vehicle. Horse or pony not to have been placed First in harness prior to 1st January 2022.

The winner to receive The Wentworth Myndwr Memorial Challenge Trophy.

#### **Class 4      EXERCISE VEHICLES**

Open to horses and ponies, 4 years old or over. A single, pair or tandem driven to a carriage of non-traditional type design and includes those with pneumatic tyres specifically designed for carriages (i.e. not car tyres). Lamps need not be carried. Judging will include general cleanliness, safety of turnout, correct fitting of harness and vehicle suitability.

This class may be split into 2 & 4 Wheel vehicles if sufficient entries.

### **Class 2b            RIDE & DRIVE            Driven Section**

Singles only - open to traditional and non traditional vehicles

Winner to receive the Tom Parker Farm Trophy.

### **Class 5            PRIVATE DRIVING - OPEN**

Open to Horses and ponies 4 years old or over, driven to a traditional or traditional type vehicle. A traditional vehicle means a vehicle of traditional profile and identifiable type to resemble the design of a carriage built prior to the First World War. The vehicle may be made from modern materials but must have traditional style springing and carriage lamps. Pneumatic tyred vehicles, trade turnouts and show wagons are not eligible.

If sufficient entries the Private Driving may be split by height 13.2hh and under and over 13.2hh

#### **Victoria Food Company Qualifier - Private Driving Championship**

The overall winner of the Private Driving class to receive the Grayswood Johnboy Memorial Trophy.

### **Class 6            CONCOURS D'ELEGANCE**

Open to singles, pairs, multiples, 4 years old or over, to a traditional type vehicle. The essence of the class is the word 'elegance' and the winner will be the turnout which, in the opinion of the Judge, presents the most elegant effect. To include vehicle, horse, driver, passenger etc. but above all the general impression.

Attention may be paid to driver's/passengers' personal costume, but fancy dress or period costume is definitely barred. The whole object of the class is to establish which turnout presents the most pleasing picture and normal judging criteria does not apply. It is judged from a distance and vehicles are NOT closely inspected. To be driven at park pace.

The winner will receive the Tessa Johnstone Memorial Trophy.

## **East Ring - Continued**

### **Class 7      LIGHT TRADE**

Open to Horses and ponies 4 years old or over, singles and pairs to a traditional or traditional type trade vehicle. No goods to be carried or displayed. A small sample load may be carried on a coster turnout only.

The winner to receive the Maurice Page Memorial Trophy.

This class is kindly sponsored by Sam Searle and Roger Page.

### **Class 8      PLEASURE DRIVING**

Pleasure Driving classes are for newcomers to showing and not intended for those who show in private driving classes.

Open to horses, ponies, donkeys & mules, 4 years old or over. A single, pair or tandem driven to a vehicle capable of seating 2 or more persons. Traditional or non traditional vehicles are permitted, and for the purposes of this class they will be judged on equal merit. Pneumatic tyres specifically designed for carriages (i.e., not car tyres) are allowed. Lamps need not be carried.

To be judged on general cleanliness, safety of turnout, correct fitting of harness and vehicle suitability. To be judged: 15% vehicle suitability, fit and cleanliness; 15% harness suitability, fit and cleanliness; 70% driver & groom, horse/pony, way of going and suitability as a family pleasure animal. Competitors may, for example, be required to drive and halt between two pairs of cones and/or be given other specific movements to execute in their show.

**Victoria Food Company Qualifier** - Pleasure Driving Championship

The winner to receive the Barbara Mills Memorial Trophy.

### **Class 9      COLOURED HORSE OR PONY**

Open to Buckskin, Cremello, Dun, Palamino, Piebald, Roan, Skewbald, and spotted horses and ponies 4 years old or over, singles, pairs and tandems, put to a traditional or modern vehicle.

Class may be split by vehicle size if sufficient entries.

This Class is not open to trade turnouts.

Winner to receive the Coloured Horse or Pony Trophy.

## **PLEASE NOTE - BDS SAFETY RULES**

### **To be followed by everyone**

No bridle to be removed whilst horse is attached to a vehicle.

No horse to be tied to anything while attached to a vehicle.

No horse to be left unattended whilst attached to a vehicle.

No horse to be driven from ground whilst attached to a vehicle.

No person to be aboard a vehicle with horse(s) attached unless the driver is in the driving seat and holding the reins.

If the driver dismounts, then a groom must be in control of the horse(s) by holding the head by means of a lead rope attached to the bit ring or head collar or by holding the reins close to the horse's head.

Members under the age of 18 are accompanied and supervised by a competent adult at all times when driving and/or handling a horse.

Participants may be told that: They may not start/be required to withdraw if they breach BDS Safety Rules or horse/vehicle/harness is unsound/unsafe/faulty or handling/driving causes safety concerns.

# **RULES**

1. No horse or pony under the age of 4 to be driven in any class.
2. The Judge's decision is final.
3. Show Officials and Stewards must be obeyed at all times.
4. All entrants and whips must be current members of the British Driving Society and membership numbers to be provided on your entry form.
5. This event will be run in accordance with the British Driving Society safety rules. All participants to adhere to these rules.
6. Young Drivers – the driver must be between 8 years of age and 17 on the day of the show. A driver under the age of 18 must be accompanied in the vehicle by a competent and responsible person aged 18 years or over.
7. Drivers, grooms and passengers under the age of 14 years must wear a correctly fitted hard hat whilst on any horse drawn vehicle and this includes grooms who have dismounted to assist with the horse(s).
8. The organisation reserve the right to omit, divide or amalgamate any class, vary the order of the classes and times, refuse entry, withhold a prize, cancel the show or disqualify a competitor at their discretion.
9. In the event of the show being cancelled entry fees received to date will be returned.
10. No entry fee will be refunded if an entrant withdraws unless supported by a Vet's or Doctor's certificate.
11. Please park as directed by the Stewards.
12. Riders must wear hard hats to the approved standard.
13. All dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
14. Please do not muck out your horsebox onto the show ground.
15. Please take all litter home with you.
16. All trophies are perpetual and must be signed for and collected from the Show Secretary and returned as agreed.
17. No liability whatsoever is accepted by the British Driving Society, the landowner or the organisers for any damage to person or property of or associated with any participant or spectator at this event.
